IMPORTANT NOTES

COLOR BELT COMPETITIONS FROM 6TH KYU TO 1ST KYU WILL BE OPEN TO ALL SHOTOKAN KARATE ORGANIZATIONS.

BLACK BELT COMPETITIONS WILL BE EXCLUSIVELY FOR ISKF MEMBERS.

In the 22-44 age group, each country may send eight women and eight men for individual competitions. In this category, each country may send only one team of men and one team of women, in both kata and kumite. In all other categories, both individual and team, each country may send as many representatives as it wishes.

6th, 5th and 4th kyu (intermediate) kata competition will be by flag system until reaching 4 finalists and these will be eliminated by point system.

At ippon kumite, feints are not allowed. At least one counterattack with a kick is mandatory.

3rd, 2nd and 1st kyu (advanced) kata competition will be by flag system until reaching 4 finalists and these will be eliminated by point system. Semifinals will be by jyu ippon kumite and the final by shobu ippon kumite. At jiyu ippon kumite, the attacker may not be jumping or feinting. In the case of the defender, he must make at least one different counterattack using a kick.

Black belts kata competition will be by flag system until reaching 4 finalists and these will be eliminated by point system. The kumite competition will be by shobu ippon kumite.

Each category must have a minimum of 8 competitors, otherwise the competitors must move on to the next higher category.

TIMELINES / REGISTRATION

The deadline for registration is August 10th, 2026

All registrations and fees must be submitted by the Country Representative (Head of delegation) on behalf of the participants.

The Country Representative should register competitors, teams, Coaches, Managers, Judges, dan and Judges examination candidates, Sayonara Party participants as well as acquisitions of t-shirts.

All Black belt participants, including competitors, Judges and Officials, must have a current ISKF membership card as well as an ISFK Passport.

This requirement will not be mandatory for color belts since their competition will be open to all Shotokan organizations.





INFORMATION FOR JUDGES AND REFEREES

Selection of Championship Judges and Referees

We expect a large number of competitors for this event.

In order for it to run smoothly and timely we will need as many ISKF Qualified Judges and Referees as possible. Please encourage the Judges and Referees in your country to come to this World Shoto Cup and participate as Championship officials.

All Judges and Referees must wear gray pants, white long-sleeve shirt, maroon tie and navy blazer on all Friday afternoon, Saturday and Sunday competitions.

Please register through your Country representative with your name, current Judge level, and registration number by August 10, 2026.

Registration for Judges / Referees Qualification course and exam

Register through your Country representative with your name, current Judge/Referee level and registration number by August 10, 2026.

All examinees must be checked in by 10:30 a.m. on thursday October 22, 2026 at the Central Dojo ISKF Merida.

All examinees with a previous Judge ranking must present an ISKF Passport at check-in.

- 3.- ISKF Fist protectors (Mits / Gloves)
Under 18s from other associations can wear equivalent white gloves.

Please note that the maximum thickness of the gloves accepted will be 1.5 cm.

- 5.- Standard belt.
- 6.- Chest protection for ladies (optional).

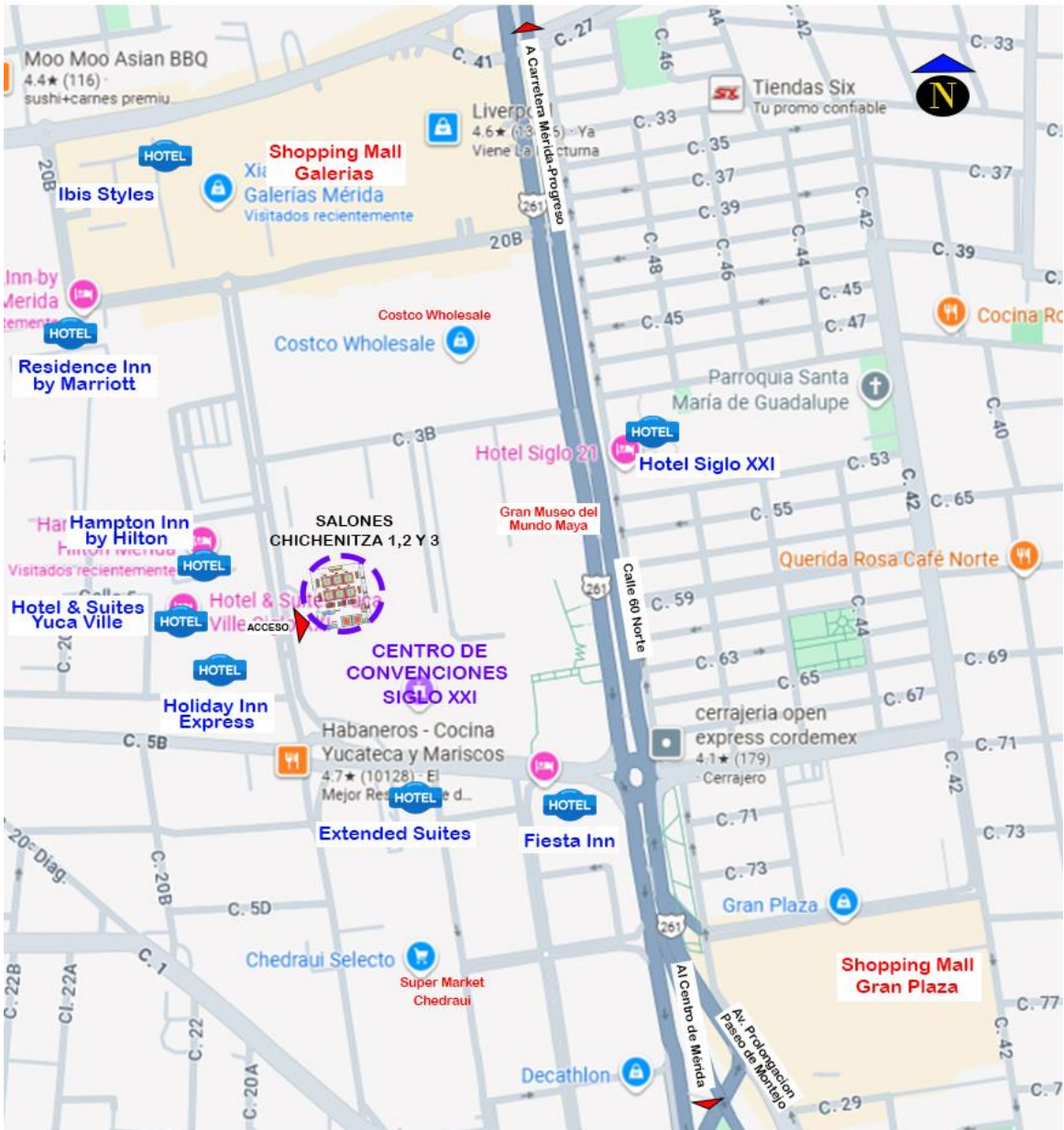

Transportation from Merida Airport (MID) to the city:

There are several options: taxis, minivans, and the modern bus system called Va y Ven, which can take you directly to the city center (please note that most of the recommended hotels are in the north of the city). From there, you can take a taxi or use the Uber and DiDi apps. Va y Ven buses operate with cards purchased at any Oxxo store, as well as with credit or debit cards.

The cost of a taxi from the airport to the city center is approximately \$400 pesos or \$20 USD.

The cost of a taxi from the airport to the north of the city is approximately \$500 Mexican pesos or \$25 USD.

Transportation from Cancun Airport (CUN) to Merida:

The most common and economical way to travel between these two cities is by ADO bus, which offers a comfortable and direct service between the ADO terminals in Cancun and Merida. The cities are 310 km apart, and the trip takes approximately 3 hours and 15 minutes. Prices are approximately 700 Mexican pesos (\$35 USD) for the standard ADO service and approximately 1,000 pesos (\$50 USD) for the platinum ADO service. From the Altabrisa ADO station in Merida, you can take an Uber, DiDi, or taxi to your hotel or final destination.

Note: Do not use a taxi from Cancun airport to Merida as the cost is very high

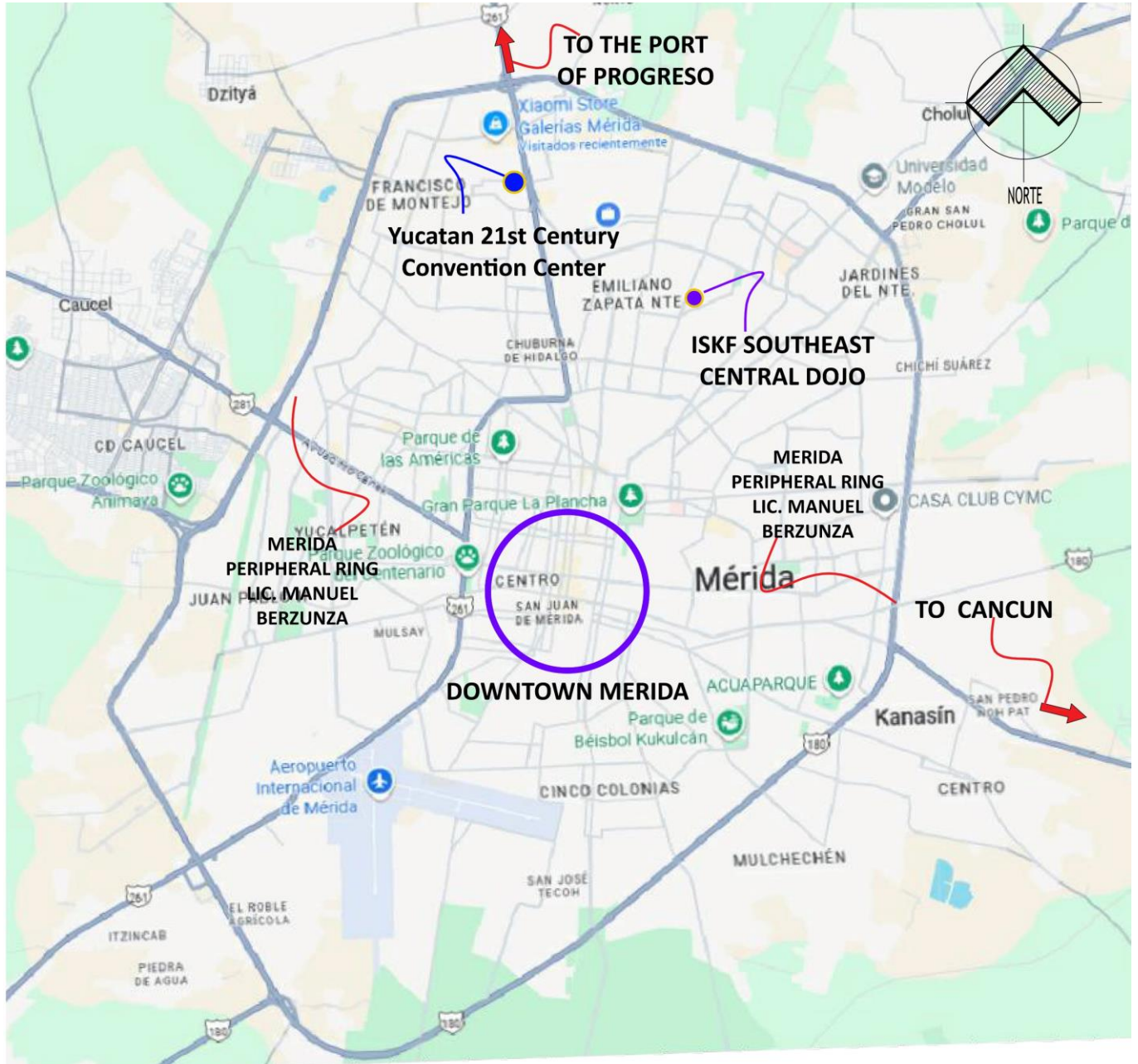

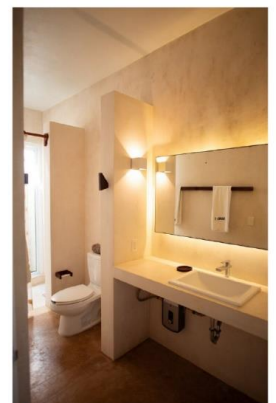

Located 100 km from Mérida, it demonstrates what Puuc art is, built in the parallelepiped forms of its buildings, with smooth walls and ornate friezes. Most of the Uxmal buildings belong to the Classic Maya period and some to the late middle phase. , Chaac is



represented in multiple buildings, in the palace of the governor, quadrangle of the nuns, the temple of the fortune-teller, among others.



The name *Kabah* or *Kabaah* was first suggested by Estanislao Carrillo in 1846 and is usually taken to be archaic Maya language for "strong hand".^[2] This is a pre-Columbian name for the site, mentioned in the *Book of Chilam Balam of Chumayel*.^[2] An alternative name is *Kabahaucan* or "royal snake in the hand," suggested by Teoberto Maler.^[2]

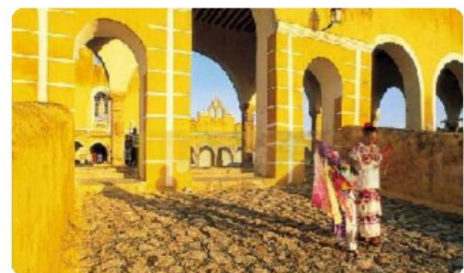

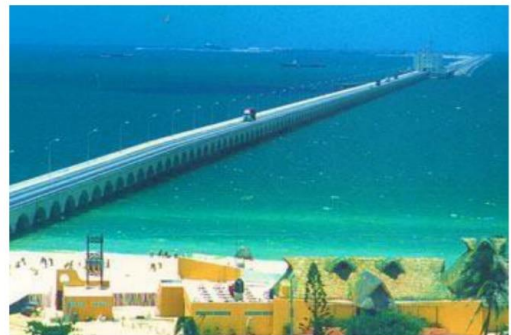

The water in Las Coloradas, Yucatan, is pink. This color is due to the high concentration of salt and the presence of halobacteria, microorganisms that produce reddish pigments in saline environments.

The pink color of the water in Las Coloradas is most intense during the dry, warm season, and during midday, when sunlight is most intense.

It is often possible to observe large flocks of flamingos painting the sky pink, while taking a boat ride. At the end of the flamingo sighting, you will be directed to the "Mayan Bath" where you will enjoy a refreshing bath in the red waters of these pink-colored lakes and then a Mayan bath, where you will rub sand all over your body and after a while, your skin will be soft and clean. This is due to its high concentrations of sulfur, minerals, salts and algae that act as exfoliants for the skin, leaving a feeling of softness throughout our body. Thanks to its high amounts of salt in this mud you will float easily. At the end of the trip, we will go to the Los Negritos restaurant for lunch (not included in price) and return to Merida.
